

What is a Precinct?

Precinct defined:

- The smallest division of a state, county, and township, comprised of no more than 2000 active voters. **Active voter** is defined as a voter who has voted in one election in the last four years or has responded to an address confirmation notice. (IC 5-2-1.7)

Purpose of a precinct:

- To maintain local involvement, engagement, and representation in government and political parties.

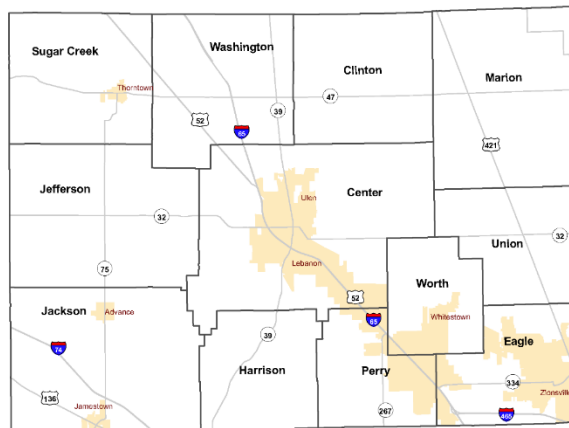

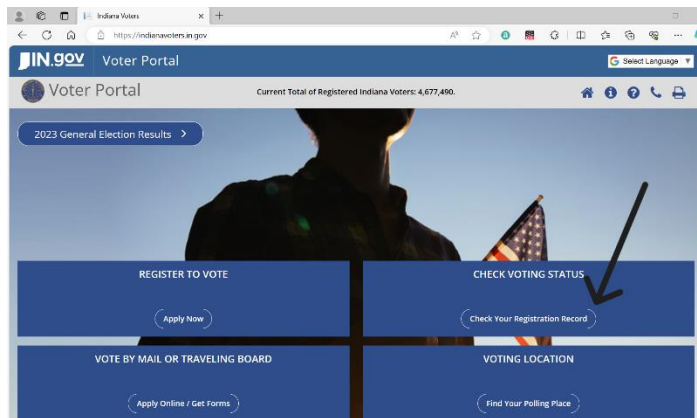

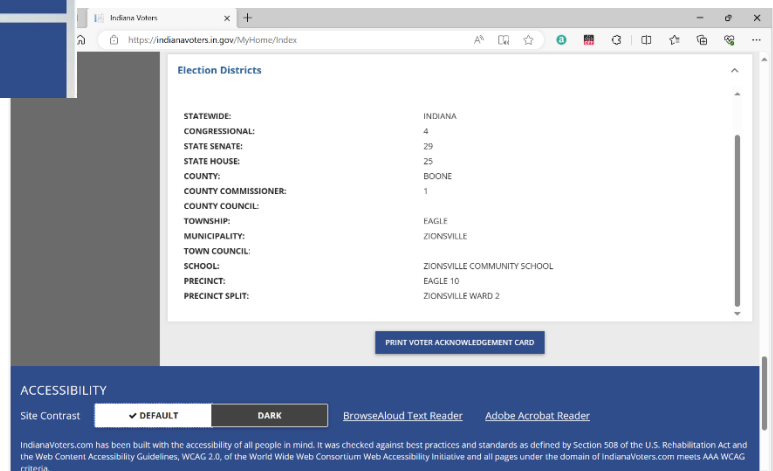
Precinct determined:

[Indiana Voters](https://indianavoters.in.gov) provides voters with election district information including a voter's precinct.



Step One: Click Check Voter Registration and complete information requested in pop-up screen.

Step Two: Scroll to the bottom of the screen to find "Election Districts". "Print Voter Acknowledgement Card" for a hard copy of Voter Registration and respective election districts.



Government: Governing bodies such as Boone County Commissioners, Boone County Council Districts, and Town/City Council Districts represent specific precincts.

Commissioners Districts

Each Commissioner resides in one of the three districts in Boone County and runs for election based on the district. However, each commissioner represents and is elected by all citizens of the county. Below is a list of the commissioners and their districts. Additionally, we have provided a map that shows the district boundaries.

County Council Districts

Four of the seven Council Members reside in one of the 4 districts in Boone County. They run for election based on their district and they represent the citizens of that district. Three other Council Members reside in Boone County but are elected as "At-Large" representatives and they represent all citizens in the county. Below is a list of the council members and their districts. Additionally we have provided a map that shows the district boundaries.

Political parties: The Republican party is built "bottom-up" with a precinct committeeman (PC) representing each precinct.
